



Returning to St. Nessan's NS

This is a short summary of our full Response Plan for easy reference.



School opening and closing times are **staggered**.

- Drop off at the main gates maintaining 2m distance.
- Pick up from the main gates maintaining 2m distance.



Pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school.



To pick up a child during school hours, please phone first.



There will be no access to the classroom for parents or visitors, except in exceptional circumstances.



All staff will complete COVID induction training.



As per current guidelines, all staff will wear a mask where a 2m distance is not possible.



Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly, using the proper technique.



Everyone will use the hand sanitizer provided on entry and exit. Each classroom will be cleaned daily. Toys will be disinfected weekly.



Pupils must be kept home with **high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell**. Pupils should also be kept home if generally unwell.



Pupils should stay home for 14 days after returning from a country not on the green list.



If showing symptoms, pupil will be isolated, and parents called. Parents will contact GP.



Each class is one Bubble. Children will sit in Pods (pairs/groups) in their classrooms.



Pods will be 1m apart.



All pupils will have an individual box (provided by the school) in which to keep textbooks and equipment.



Any shared resources will be wiped down after use.



Pupils will not be assigned homework in the first week they return.
